- 3. SPONSOR one boy and one girl
- 4. Your club can sponsor more than two delegates and/or delegates from other clubs in District 7720.
- 5. Ask a member of your club to be a counselor or serve at the Friday night Etiquette Dinner.

The Club responsibilities are:

- 1. Distribute Delegate Package
- 2. Select candidates
- 3. Check to see that all five forms are completed
- MAIL completed application to:

- 5. Clubs will be billed \$220.00 per delegate upon receipt of application.

- 6. Scholarships for other club's candidates are to be sent to District 7720, P O Box 1621, Manteo, NC 27954
- 7. ARRANGE for delegates are to be transported to and from the 4-H Center in Columbia, NC by a Rotarian. Several area clubs can van pool if need be. Let the delegates know who will be driving, where to meet, and when the vehicle will depart and return. Delegates must arrive by noon on Friday and picked up no later than 11:30 AM on Sunday.
